- Duration of the project: 24 months (From 1.12.2022 30.11.2024)






Project basics – Partnership

Project basics – main activities



- The project is broken down into 7 3-day events:
 - Tentative schedule:
 - 1. Kick-off event in Cestica, HR: March 29-31, 2023 (85 participants; 45 are international persons)
 - Theme: Organizing volunteers and civil protection actions
 - 2. Event 2 in Ajdovscina, SI (organized by Sopotniki); late May 2023 (90 participants; 45 international)
 - Theme: Promoting inter-generational solidarity and responding to the needs of the elderly





Tentative schedule:

3. Event in Heiningen, DE: Sept 2023 (80 participants; 40 international)



- Theme: Organizing actions that enhance social inclusion & environmental protection
- 4. Event in Cavriago, IT; November 2023 (80 participants; 40 international)
 - Theme: Enhancing citizen engagement in education actions and the mental well-being of families
- 5. Event in Usseaux, IT; (85 participants; 45 international); late may or early June 2024
 - Theme: Engaging citizens in actions that contribute to preserving cultural and nature assets in remote areas







Tentative schedule:

6. Event in Sasd, HU (organized by "Sásd és Térsége Terület": September 2024 (80 participants; 40 international)

- Theme: Addressing the mental well-being of the most vulnerable during pandemic – elderly persons and persons w/disabilities
- 7. Final event in Ormož, SI (organized by Ormož and Cestica): late October 2024
 - Theme: Adapting community events so that they promote tourism and solidarity in the community







End results of the project?

- Enhanced capacities in rural areas to prepare and participate in actions that contribute to rural communities overcoming COVID-19;
- Improved awareness among citizens in rural communities about how EU policies/values positively impact the quality of life;
- Enhanced cooperation between rural communities
